# Pre-Kindergarten 3/4/5 Year Old Program

Pre-Kindergarten students must be age 3 by August 31st of the year starting our program.

### **Extended Day Care:**

Early morning care from 7:00 a.m. to 7:35 a.m. is offered at no charge for students in grades K-8. You may be eligible for the child dependent care credit for these expenses. Consult your tax advisor.

**PreK 3/4/5 only 2:30-4:30 p.m.**; **K 2:30-5:30 p.m. -** \$16.50 per hr.
